Empire KnowledgeBank eLearning Program Guidelines

Overview

The Empire KnowledgeBank (EKB) eLearning Program provides UUP-represented employees the ability to access thousands of eLearning products including courses, eBooks, and brief videos, through an EKB license issued by Enterprise Training Solutions, Inc. Employees are provided an opportunity to enhance their professional development by building skills, preparing for certification exams, and earning continuing education units (CEUs) and professional development units (PDUs) in a variety of areas.

An EKB license is available at no expense to the campus or the employee, and allows users to access content anytime and anywhere with an internet connection. Employees will need supervisory approval to access EKB content during normal business hours.

General Program Information

- EKB licenses are valid May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025.
- Employees must apply for an EKB license using the [NYS/UUP JLMC EKB Application](#) which may be accessed at: [EKB License Application \(ny.gov\)](#).
- Employees must have prior approval of the appropriate division, department, or program staff to access EKB eLearning content during normal business hours. See application for the Acknowledgment of Division/Department/Program.
- Employees may access EKB content after work hours, using their own equipment/technology, without prior approval.
- EKB content may be accessed anywhere with an internet connection.
- If an employee does not use an EKB license within 60 days of the date it was issued, the license may be deactivated.

Eligibility

All UUP-represented employees are eligible to apply for an EKB license.
